

MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING HELD ON 04/04/2015 AT 11.00 A.M. IN THE SHANTIPUR M.E. SCHOOL, LAKHIPUR G.P. UNDER LAKHIPUR LAC, CACHAR.

Members Presents: Vide Annexure –A

Shri G.M. Hazarika, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar presided over the meeting and welcomed Hon'ble M.P., 2 H.P., Silchar, Hon'ble MLA, Lakhipur LAC, ZP Members, President and Secretary of Lakhinagar G.P. AP Members and all the Officers present in the meeting, the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, gratefully acknowledged and commended the praiseworthy role played by Ms. Sushmita Dev. Hon'ble M.P., 2 H.P., Silchar by selecting Lakhinagar G.P. as the Model Village under SAGY. He, then requested all the Heads of Departments to come up with the Model Plan for developing the Lakhinagar G.P. as Model Village. He requested Hon'ble MP to address the House.

Hon'ble MP thanked the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar for conducting the DDC Meeting at Lakhinagar G.P. and requested the concerned Heads of Departments to fill up the critical gap of infrastructure facility and select suitable Scheme based on local needs.

Hon'ble MLA suggested that the developmental departments should give right emphasis on road communication being the first priority followed by water supply and electricity. He also requested the Departmental Heads to earmark/keep a portion of their development fund for this Model Village so that the Village can be transformed as Model under SAGY.

Shri A.R. Sheikh, ACS, Addl. Deputy Commissioner (Dev.) explained the Guidelines for preparation of Village Development Plan under SAGY and requested the Departmental Heads to take up short term Schemes in their respective Action Plan so that these can be completed within twelve months period as the same is a time bound Programme.

Department-Wise discussions were as follows:

1. AGRICULTURE:-

The DAO informed the House that the agricultural procedures are not sufficient land of and there is a deficiency in the production of rice, pulse and oilseeds. He stated that the land is fertile and suitable for cultivation of Rice, Pulses especially Masur Dal and vegetables. Only there is need of assured irrigation and organic farming which can be possible in this village if planned concerted effort is being taken.

The DAO had expressed that the Schemes like construction of bunds, water harvesting tank can be done with the help of DRDA. A protection bund about 2-Kms is required to be constructed from the house of Sujit Barman to the house of Pulin Barman near the foot hill of Rani Colony and Khasia Punjee. The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar, then requested the D.O., Soil Conservation to look into the matter and include the same in the Annual Action Plan of IWMP.

(Action: District Agriculture Officer, E.E. Agril, Silchar, DRDA, Cachar, Silchar and Soil Conservation, Cachar, Silchar.)

IRRIGATION:-

The Executive Engineer, Irrigation informed the House that there is no existing Irrigation Scheme in Lakhinagar G.P. at present. He stated that Flow Irrigation Scheme on Lakhicherra Nala at Riang Basti area of Lakhinagar G.P. may be taken to cover about 200 Hectares of Crop Lands with an amount of Rs. 450 Lakhs which is long term project. The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested Executive Engineer, Irrigation to submit the proposal to the Govt. and take up some short term Scheme like Lift Irrigation Schemes from Jiri River for assured irrigation of land for increasing the agricultural productions.

(Action: Executive Engineer, Irrigation, Cachar, Silchar.)

3. APDCL:-

As regards RGVY, the Asstt. General Manager, APDCL, Cachar, Silchar informed the House that the implementation of the Scheme will be started within next two months. He, further informed that the proposal under RGVY was submitted for an amount of Rs. 274 Crores covering all the Villages, but only Rs. 154 Crores have been sanctioned. Hon'ble MLA, Lakhipur LAC requested the AGM, APDCL, Cachar, Silchar to ensure that Lakhinagar G.P. is fully covered under RGVY. The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested the AGM, APDCL, Cachar, Silchar to submit the Status Report within 5 (five) days.

(Action: AGM, APDCL Div -I & II, Cachar, Silchar.)

4. P.H.E.:-

The Executive Engineer, PHE, Div -II, Cachar, Silchar informed the House that 4 Nos. of PHE Plants available in this G.P. are defunct and ensured to activate all the Schemes within 6 (six) months to meet up the demands of water. He, further informed that the area is not suitable for deep tube well and testing is on for installation of Tara Pump. If found suitable, Tara Pumps would be installed within 3-4 months.

The Executive Engineer, PHE, Div -II, Cachar, Silchar requested Hon'ble MLA, Lakhipur LAC to allot at least 25 to 30 Nos. of Tara Pumps from his LADS Fund for installation of the same in this G.P.

The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested the Executive Engineer, PHE, Div -II, Cachar, Silchar to make the village open defecation free under **Swaccha Mission** by 2nd Oct' 2015.

(Action: EE, PHE Div -II, Cachar, Silchar.)

5. P.W.D. (RR):-

Hon'ble MP, MLA and the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar expressed dissatisfaction on poor road communication of Lakhinagar G.P. and asked the EE, PWD (RR) to take immediate necessary steps for early completion of existing ongoing Schemes. Regarding non-completion of two bridges on Jirighat- Lakhinagar Road approved in the year 2007-08, the EE, PWD (RR) informed that due to expiry of the date of Administrative Approval, the approaches of both the bridges remained incomplete. Hon'ble MP suggested the Executive Engineer, PWD (RR) to move to the Govt. for extension of approval of these Schemes with a copy to Hon'ble MLA, Laxhipur LAC so that he could be able to pursue the matter at the Govt. level. The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar asked the EE, PWD (RR) to complete all the existing works under Lakhinagar G.P. including the incomplete bridges within July' 2015.

(Action: EE, PWD (RR), Cachar, Silchar.)

6. EDUCATION:-

The Inspector of Schools, CDC, Cachar, Silchar informed the House that there is only one Venture High School in Lakhinagar G.P. The Inspector of Schools, CDC, Cachar, Silchar and District Elementary Education Officer cum DMC, Cachar, Silchar were requested to submit report showing the No. of Govt. Schools, No. of Students, Toilet Facilities for Boys and Girls, Teachers and Students Ratio under RTE within 10th April' 2015 positively so that Action Plan can be prepared in the light of report.

(Action: IS, CDC & DEEO cum DMC, Cachar, Silchar.)

7. HEALTH:-

The Joint Director, Health Services, Cachar, Silchar informed the House that Lakhinagar G.P. has only one Health Sub-Centre which is running in a rented house. So, proposal for construction of Govt. Building has already been submitted to the Mission Director, N.H.M., Assam for sanction. The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar asked the Joint Director, Health Services, Cachar, Silchar to pursue the matter at the Govt. level for early sanction.

On a query from the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar regarding Immunization, Anti Natal Check-Up etc., the Joint Director, Health Services, Cachar, Silchar informed that all the programmes are going on in the G.P. on a regular basis.

The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar suggested for holding regular Camps in that G.P. and include the same in the Action Plan.

(Action: Joint Director, Health Services, Cachar, Silchar.)

8. D.R.D.A.:-

The Project Director, DRDA, Cachar, Silchar cum Charge Officer under SAGY informed that for development of Lakhinagar village, there is ample scope for taking up Schemes under MGNREGA. The Block Development Officer, Lakhipur Development Block was directed to prepare a plan and submit the Project Director, DRDA, Cachar, Silchar so that need based Scheme can be taken up under this programme. The Project Director, DRDA, Cachar, Silchar was requested for the deputation of one Junior Engineer to look after different Development Schemes under SAGY in this G.P. with intimation to Hon'ble MP, Silchar, MLA, Lakhipur LAC and the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar.

Under NRLM Programme, the Project Director, DRDA, Cachar, Silchar was asked to take up a project of weaving with modern amenities including Facilitation Centre, for upgradation of skills, training of Traditional Weavers and arrangement for market linkage for selling their produces.

The D.P.R. was asked to submit the same to the Govt. for approval.

(Action: Project Director, DRDA, Cachar, Silchar.)

9. D.S.W.O.:-

The CDPO, Lakhipur ICDS informed the House that total No. of AWCs in Lakhinagar Village is 16 Nos. out of which 5 Nos. are not functioning properly due to damages of the Buildings which need renovation.

The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested to submit the proposal by incorporating it in the Action Plan.

(Action: DSWO & CDPO, Lakhipur ICDS.)

10. Fishery:-

The DFDO, Cachar, Silchar informed the House that there are number of existing ponds which can be developed, renovated for Fish Culture.

The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar has asked to submit the Action Plan incorporating the same and in convergence with DRDA for early completion for Fish Culture.

(Action: DFDO & PD, DRDA, Cachar, Silchar.)

11. Handloom & Textiles:-

The Asstt. Director, Handloom & Textiles, Cachar, Silchar was requested to re-submit the Action Plan by taking Short Time Plan for upgradation of the Traditional Weavers.

(Action: The Asstt. Director, Handloom & Textiles, Cachar, Silchar.)

12. Water Resources:-

The Executive Engineer, Water Resources Department, Cachar, Silchar was requested to make a field visit at the erosion effected portion of Jiri River with the A.P, G.P. and Ward Members and submit the Action Plan accordingly.

(Action: EE, Water Resources Department, Cachar, Silchar.)

13. Dairy & A.H. Vety:-

The Dairy Development Officer, Cachar, Silchar was requested to make a field level survey and submit a proposal for Dairy Development as there is much scope for development.

As the area is suitable for goatery, the District AH & Vety. Officer, Cachar, Silchar was requested to propose Short Term Programme for development of High breeds Goatery Farm in the Action Plan.

(Action: Dist. AH & Vety. Officer, Cachar, Silchar.)

14. Sericulture:-

The Asstt. Director, Sericulture, Cachar, Silchar informed that the soil type and the atmosphere is very much suitable for Muga rearing, Eri rearing are being done by the people of this area in indigenous methods. The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested the Asstt. Director, Sericulture, Cachar, Silchar to take up Short Term Schemes for development of Muga rearing and modernize the Eri rearing and submit the Action Plan accordingly.

(Action: The Asstt. Director, Sericulture, Cachar, Silchar.)

.. Bank:-

Regarding opening of Bank Branch in Jirighat, the L.D.M., Cachar, Silchar informed that survey work for opening of I.D.B.I. Branch has been done. Proposal for opening the Branch would be submitted to their higher authority for approval as information received from IDBI, Silchar.


(Action: LDM, Cachar, Silchar.)

16. Misc:-

The matter of short supply of Kerosene Oil to the Village was raised by AP Member and requested the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar to increase especially for the villagers. The S.D.O. (Civil), Lakhimpur was asked to look into the matter and take necessary measures to mitigate the issue.

In the concluding speech, Hon'ble MP requested all the concerned Officers to take it as a challenge for development of Lakhinagar G.P. as one of the best villages under SAGY. Hon'ble MP also requested all the Officers to keep liason with the G.P. and A.P. Members as and when required. Hon'ble MP also requested the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar to review the progress under this programme regularly and suggested to hold another meeting in the village in the month of July/August 2015.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks from the Chair.
