

MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING HELD ON 05/05/2015 AT 11.00 A.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF THE OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, CACHAR, SILCHAR

Members Presents: Vide Annexure -A

Shri G.M. Hazarika, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar presided over the meeting.

At the very outset, he informed the House that Public Accounts on Legislative Assembly Committee would visit Cachar District on 06-05-2015 and requested all the concerned District Heads to keep ready all the relevant information pertaining to last two years and place the same before the Committee during their visit.

The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar also read out the relevant papers received at the Conference Hall of DC-SP Conference held on 21-04-2015 and 22-04-2015 and requested concerned Heads to take necessary action in consultation with concerned Additional Deputy Commissioners. He also state that special initiative should be taken on Swachha Abhiyan and continued for Cleanliness Drive.

The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar expressed displeasure over the absence of some of the District Heads in the District Development Committee Meeting for which Inter-Departmental discussions could not be undertaken. He, then directed the absentees to explain the reason for their absence.

The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested all the District Heads to take necessary action for preparation of Road Mapping for Monitoring System and submit the Road Map at the earliest.

He, also stated that target for the financial year 2015-16 to be fixed by enhancing 25% of previous financial year.

He then started Department-Wise discussions which were as follows:

1. AGRICULTURE:-

The DAO informed the House that achievement of KCC for the month of May is sponsored 14, 428 Nos., disbursed 11, 174 Nos. He also stated that final selection process is going on under ATMA for reward and incentives (Best Representative Groups from Vety, Fishery etc. @ 1 No.) Further, representative of DAO stated that construction of 200 Mt. Gowdown at DAO Complex is going on under RKVY and distribution of 130 Nos of Power Tillar have been completed under RKVY.

The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested the DAO to expedite the work

2. AGRICULTURAL ENGINEERING:-

Progress for the month of May could not be reviewed due to the absence of Executive Engineer, Agri or his representative and progress report has also not been received.

(Action: Executive Engineer, Agri, Cachar, Silchar.)

3. P.W.D. (Rural Roads):-

On a query from the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar about the progress of Assam University, Silchar, the Executive Engineer, PWD (RR) informed that 90% progress has so far been made. The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar expressed concern over deplorable condition of Town Road. In reply to this, EE, PWD (RR) informed that there is hardly any fund earmarked for repairing of the Town Roads. He also intimated that an amount of Rs. 2.00 Cr. is required for the purpose.

The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested the EE, PWD (RR) to take up the matter with the higher concerned authority for maintenance and repairing of the roads.

The EE, PWD (RR), Silchar informed the House that the restoration cost of repairing of Road Cutting for water supply connection deposited by the party could not be utilized in the field. Due to PWD Accounting System it is required to be deposited into the Govt. Head of A/C through Treasury but there is no System of withdrawal of the same and thus repairing of road could not be made. He also suggested as the permission is issued by the Municipal Board, the restoration of road cutting may be entrusted to Municipal Board in consultation with concerned PWD, AEE.

(Action: Executive Engineer, PWD (RR), Silchar.)

4. P.W.D. (NEC):-

Progress for the month of May could not be reviewed due to the absence of Executive Engineer, NEC or his representative and progress report has also not been received.

5. IRRIGATION:-

The Executive Engineer, Irrigation, Cachar, Silchar informed the House that out of 13 Nos of Schemes 6 Nos. have been completed and the rest is expected to be completed within 2016.

As Monsoon season is at the door-step, the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested the EE, Irrigation to keep a close eye on the Sluice Gate so as to keep them functional.

The Executive Engineer, Irrigation, Cachar, Silchar further intimated that the Cropping Pattern of Lakhinagar G.P. is yet to be received from the DAO and in turn the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested the DAO, Cachar, Silchar to provide the same to the Executive Engineer, Irrigation, Cachar, Silchar at the earliest.

(Action: EE, Irrigation, Cachar, Silchar and DAO, Cachar, Silchar)

6. HEALTH:-

The Joint Director, Health Services, Cachar, Silchar informed the House that almost 90% of Vaccination in connection to Japanese Encephalitis have been completed.

The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested the Jt. Director, Health Services to submit a status report on H1N1 Virus and ensure regular submission of schemes under NRHM like Majoni, Mamoni, Morom and Momota Kits. He also requested the DPM, NRHM to monitor all the Sub-Centres and submit report from time to time.

The Joint Director, Health Services, Cachar, Silchar informed the House that 1 No. of Sub-Centre has been sanctioned for Modal Village i.e. Lakhinagar under Lakhinagar G.P.

(Action: Joint Director, Health Services, Cachar, Silchar.)

7. D.R.D.A.:-

The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested all the District Heads to submit the Annual Action Plan under SAGY if not submitted yet. The Project Director, DRDA, Cachar, Silchar was also requested to compile all the Action Plans and submit the Village Development Plan by 15th May 2015.

On a query from the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar regarding submission of UC for Individual Household Latrine (IHHL), the PD, DRDA, Cachar, Silchar informed that the UC has been submitted. The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested the PD, DRDA to ensure the completion of those IHHL which are found to be defective.

(Action: Project Director, DRDA, Cachar, Silchar.)

8. Fishery:-

The DFDO, Cachar, Silchar informed the House that the Fish Production for the month of April 2015 was around 415 MT from all the captured and cultured fishery resources and the cumulative total is 415 MT. The achievement is 1.56% against the annual fish production of 26650 MT. The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested the DFDO, Cachar, Silchar to expedite the fish production.

He also informed the House that the inaugural Programme of Modern Hygienic Fish Market of New Market (Fatak Bazar), Silchar was successfully completed on 29th April 2015.

(Action: DFDO, Cachar, Silchar.)

9. DSWO:-

Progress for the month of May could not be reviewed due to the absence of DSWO Cachar, or his representative and progress report has also not been received.

(Action: DSWO, Cachar, Silchar.)

10. A.H. Vety:-

The District AH & Vety. Officer, Cachar, Silchar informed that the proposal for Short Term Programme for development of High breeds Goatery Farm in the Action Plan will be submitted shortly.

The Deputy Commissioner, Cachar, Silchar requested the District AH & Vety. Officer, Cachar, Silchar to inspect all the Slaughter House and submit report in the next DDC Meeting.

11. Soil Conservation:-

Progress for the month of May could not be reviewed due to the absence of DO, Soil Conservation, Cachar, or his representative and progress report has also not been received.
