2. Presentation of WRD Silchar Division, Silchar on vulnerable breaches and status of SDRF Schemes and flood protection measures: - The Executive Engineer, WRD presented a detailed report on the overall status of flood protection measures and SDR Schemes implementation and further the present condition of various khals of Silchar Town was also discussed in the meeting. WRD, Silchar Division was also directed to start cleaning of these khals in due co-ordination with Silchar Municipal Board, Silchar immediately by procuring logistic support from them and works should be completed before the onset of the monsoon season.

3. Presentation of WRD Mech. Div. Silchar on status of Sluice Gates and SDRF schemes: - The Executive Engineer, WRD Mech. Div, Silchar presented a detailed status report regarding functionality of all steel sluice gates within the Cachar District and

SDRF Scheme implementation status.

Executive Engineer, Silchar Mechanical W.R. Division, has submitted the revised working estimate of the scheme "Immediate measures for restoration of Steel Sluice Gate & other structures under SDRF for the year 2016-17 under Cachar District" vide letter No. MSIL/WR/TP-49/Pt- I/2017/80, dtd.-15/02/2020.

The above scheme was earlier approved in the DDMA meeting whose estimated amount was Rs.150Lakhs and subsequently Govt. has also sanctioned the scheme after approval of the SEC and accordingly "Administrative Approval" was also issued from the Revenue and DM Department. But during the execution of the works it was seen that some of the components were found in good condition and no replacement was required for which the same was not replaced and for this the bill amount got reduced to Rs.1,17,62,902/- only and the balance amount will be used for additional immediate restoration works by following procedures and later the same will be submitted for release of fund.

Moreover, after inspection it was found that the work was completed by maintaining the quality and safety of the sluice gates.

The matter was rejected in DDMA Meeting held on 27th February, 2019 at 3.00pm and minutes was issued vide memo no. CRR. 03/2018/DDMA/Part-I/51-A, Dated 28/2/2019. On receiving a petition to release the extra amount, the house examined the petition and approved it on consideration of the fact that items were supplied by them in that crucial disaster affected period.

Finally, the house directed to the concerned officials of the DDMA to release the extra amount Rs. 12, 97,401/- after observing the necessary financial procedures and take approval of the total expenditure of the relief operations for the year 2018 in the next DDMA meeting along with 2019 expenditure.

- 3. The house suggested that hereon agenda of the every DDMA Meeting will have to be circulated amongst all concerned members like Hon'ble MP, Hon'ble MLAs & all Heads of Department 3 days prior to the DDMA meetings. Further, the officials were directed to follow the same from next DDMA meeting onwards.
- 4. All Departments who have submitted the scheme under SDRF and still pending in their respective parent Department or ASDMA were directed to submit priority list of schemes along with proper damage justification report (like number of people affected/ area affected/ etc). The cost benefit analysis report is also required for sanctioning of schemes that are still pending and this methodology will be followed in the future also. Based on priority list the DDMA Cachar will write to Govt. in Revenue & DM Department and ASDMA for sanctioning of the scheme under SDRF in respect of the Cachar District.

5. The work of de-siltation & cleaning of major Khals of Silchar town needs to be started immediately. This has to be undertaken by the W.R. Department, Silchar Division in joint collaboration with Silchar Municipal Board (logistic support) from 24th February, 2020. SMB is to impose fines on people who do not follow rules or throw garbage in the khals.

A roadmap is to be prepared for upcoming Bhuwan Mela. Her& an approach route and alternate route needs to be specifically illustrated so that various agencies find it easy to reach the place if any untoward activity takes place.

10. During flood or any another natural calamity, it is mandatory to see that the rates of essential commodities does not rise up. For this a constant vigil is to be maintained by the FCS & CA Department. ADC I/c. FCS & CA, Cachar will ensure the same and report compliance.

- 11. The house directed all concerned Circle Officers and Head of Offices of the Cachar District to submit the following proposals as below mentioned timeframe:
