

MINUTES OF DISTRICT DISASTER MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY (DDMA), CACHAR MEETING HELD ON 21ST SEPTEMBER, 2021 AT 4.30 P.M IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, CACHAR, SILCHAR.

As per directions of Smti. Keerthi Jalli, I.A.S., Deputy Commissioner cum Chairperson, District Disaster Management Authority, Cachar, the meeting was presided over by Smti. J.R Lalsim, A.C.S, Chief Executive Officer, District Disaster Management Authority, Cachar.

At the outset the Chief Executive Officer, District Disaster Management Authority, Cachar welcomed all the members and thereafter discussion was initiated as per agenda.

1. Presentation of the status by **WRD C.I Division, Badarpur**: The Executive Engineer, Water Resource, C.I Division, Badarpur presented the status of all the ongoing/completed schemes. A detail discussion on the work executed was undertaken by the house. Further, he stated that there is only one pending scheme under his Division which will be completed within 31st January, 2022 without fail.
