# MINUTES OF DISTRICT DISASTER MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY (DDMA), CACHAR MEETING HELD ON 21<sup>57</sup> SEPTEMBER, 2021AT 4.30 P.M IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, CACHAR, SILCHAR.

#### Members present as per Annexure-A:

As per directions of Smti. Keerthi Jalli, I.A.S., Deputy Commissioner cum Chairperson, District Disaster Management Authority, Cachar, the meeting was presided over by Smti. J.R Lalsim, A.C.S, Chief Executive Officer, District Disaster Management Authority, Cachar.

A detail discussion on the work executed was undertaken by the house. Further, he stated that there is only one pending scheme under his Division which will be completed within 31st January, 2022 without fail.



The Executive Engineer, Water Resource, Cachar Inv. Division, Badarpur stated that the damage caused to the scheme named "Immediate measures for restoration of flood damaged from Kunapara T.E to Sindura IX PMGSY Road near River Larang on its R/B under SDRF for the year 2021-22 amounting to an estimated value of Rs. 43.00L under Katigorah LAC pertaining to Water Resource, Cachar Inv. Division, Badarpur will have adverse affects if not immediately repaired/restored. The Circle Officer, Katigorah Revenue Circle further added that if road is damaged completely, then communication with many villages will be totally disrupted. Understanding the risk and other associated factors, the house unanimously decided that this road should immediately be repaired/protected and the work has to be completed within 31st October, 2021. The fund for the same will be provided from the GR fund of DDMA, Cachar subject to replenishment

of the same from the Govt. Further, the house recommended DDMA, Cachar to provide issue order as per relevant section of DM Act 2005 by considering the urgency of the immediate restoration works and direct the Executive Engineer, Water Resource, Cachar Inv. Division, Badarpur to undertake this immediate repairing/restoration work as soon as possible and ensure completion of the same before 31st October 2021.
