The meeting was presided over by Shri. Bhupesh Chandra Das, A.C.S., District Development Commissioner cum CEO, District Disaster Management Authority, Cachar, Silchar.

At the outset the District Development Commissioner cum CEO, District Disaster Management Authority, Cachar welcomed all the members and thereafter discussion was initiated as per agenda.

After threadbare discussion, the following decisions have been taken on the Agenda items.

- 1. First of all, Confirmation of the minutes of the last DDMA Meeting held on 01-10-2020 was done and discussion was held on the action taken on the decision of the meeting.
- 2. Preparation of Departmental DM Plan & Flood Contingency plan for 2021-22: All Heads of Departments were directed to submit their Departmental DM Plan & Flood Contingency plan(both hard & soft copy) for 2021-22 within 30th April, 2021. Subsequently the District Flood Contingency plan will also be updated by DDMA, Cachar within 10th May, 2021.

3. The District Disaster Management Plan, Cachar has already been prepared and this will soon be shared with ASDMA, Govt. of Assam.

4. Status of preparedness in respect of Departments/Co-ordination matter/relief measures/ Dissemination of information to the field level functionaries of the Departments- All departments were directed to conduct their intradepartmental flood (other disaster) preparedness meeting within 30th April, 2021and thereby submit the status report to DDMA, Cachar along with updated contact numbers of all concerned from their respective departments.


5. All Line Departments were directed to conduct intra-departmental meeting regard flood response and preparedness within 30^{th} April, 2021.

12. Status of stock of essential commodities in Cachar District- The Superintendent of Food & Civil Supplies stated that adequate stock of essential commodities is available in market. He also stated that necessary co-ordination is being taken up from their end with FCI/Chamber of Commerce, Silchar, Market Associations, Others with regard to stocking up of essential commodities.

13. Status of medicine stocks by Joint Director of Health Services, Cachar- The Joint Director of Health Services, Cachar stated that there is adequate stock of medicines available at their end and they will take all necessary measures for mitigating flood keeping in view the COVID-19 situation as well.

14. Status of medicine and fodder by Vety. Department- The District Veterinary Officer, Cachar stated that there is adequate stock of medicines available at their end and they will take all necessary measures for mitigating flood keeping in view the COVID-19 situation as well. He has also stated that fodder is not available with the district. For cultivation of green fodder, as land is already available with the department, so necessary take up should be done with their higher authorities for implementation of the same.

- 15. Status of water purifying tablets and functioning status of mobile water treatment plant by PHE Division-I & PHE Division-II- The Executive Engineers of both the Divisions of PHE stated that adequate amount of purifying tablets and bleaching powder is available with the district.
- 16. Finalizing of rates for relief materials by DDMA, Cachar- This will be completed by DDMA, Cachar within first week of May, 2021 after observing required formalities.

- 17. Finalizing of rates for private boats by IWT, Silchar Division- This has been completed by IWT, Silchar Division, Cachar as responded and the rates and other details will be shared by the Executive Engineer, IWT, Silchar Division, Cachar within 10th May, 2021.

- 18. Status of SDRF Works by PWD Dept.(All four divisions)- The Executive Engineer, PWD Lakhipur (T) Road Div., Silchar & Udharbond(T) Road Division, Sonai & Dholai (T) Road Div & Katigorah- Borkhola (T) Road Division shared the current status of all schemes & works under their departmental jurisdiction.
- 19. Discussion on Relief Camp Management- All concerned departments were directed to run the Relief Camps as per Govt. laid SOP and this has to be undertaken keeping in mind the COVID-19 pandemic. (Action: DDMA, Cachar /Social Welfare Dept./Education Departments/PHE/Others)
- 20. Flood preparedness with regard to COVID-19 Protocols- All departments are requested to ensure flood preparedness and response with regard to COVID-19 Protocols.

a) The District Agricultural Officer, Cachar has stated an issue where for raising of Paddy seedlings for providing immediate relief to the farmers in case of natural

calamities as a routine programme with direct financial involvement of farmers subject to re-imbursement. But due to Non-payment of bills etc for last 2(two) consecutive years by the department, it has become difficult for the department to motivate the farmers to do it on their own expenses for Esstt. of Community Nursery. The department has requested to arrange for a fund under DDMA for the said purpose as flood preparedness and the house has committed to take up the matter with higher authorities.

A separate meeting has been proposed to be conducted for mitigating Urban Flood related issues.

c) All Departmental schemes of Water Resource(CID/Mechanical/Silchar Division) & PWD, Territorial Roads(All four Divisions), PWD(NH/Building) will have to be visited by Concerned Circle Officer and report has to be prepared based on that joint inspection only.
