Prevention, Preparedness & Mitigation Activities:

1. Volunteers Training on Search Rescue and First Aid:

DDMA have organized volunteers training on search, rescue & first-aid in association with SDRF, Silchar and local Community Based Organizations at Dudpatil, Rongpur, Malugram, Modhurbhond&Goniawala of Silchar City in 10 batches on & from 1st January 2016 to 15th February 2016. Total 276 nos. of volunteers have been trained in the aforesaid training.



2. Community Training at RPC Training Hall, Lakhipur Sub-Division on 30-01-2016

DDMA has organised a community training programme on Basics of Disaster Preparedness and Search, Rescue & First Aid on 30th January 2016 in association with local NGO viz. CICDP NEICORD (Cacharintegrated Community Development Project) at Lakhipur Sub-Division. Training organised in two batches and total 50 nos. of Volunteers has participated in the training from remote places of Lakhipur Sub-Division.



3. Workshop on Village Master Plan Sharing with Line Department and VLMCC Master Trainers Date: 01-02-2016

DDMA has organised a Half-Day Workshop on Village Master Plan sharing with line Departments and VLMCC Master Trainers Training on VMP for second phase on 1st February 2016 at DRDA Conference Hall, Silchar. It has been circulated to all line Departments of the district and also shared with the Assam State Disaster Management Authority, Govt. of Assam. This initiative has been taken for documentation of the various activities including the response activities etc. of DDMA, Cachar.



6. **Urban Flood meeting on 19.02.2016:**

DDMA has organised a meeting with Silchar Municipal Board and all line Departments for discussion on urban flood issues of Silchar City and its mitigation measures. DDMA has taken nos. of initiative for urban flood mitigation issues in association with Silchar Municipal Board - 1) Initiative for clean Silchar - "My City My Responsibility" - an initiative for Clean, Green & Safe Silchar have been launched. 2) DDMA has issued a nos. of order as per relevant section of DM Act 2005 for clean & safe Silchar. 3) Various awareness generation programmes have been taken in association with Govt. Departments & NGO's/CBO's etc. in Silchar City.



7. **Inauguration of Clean Silchar Initiative, “My City My Responsibility” 2016:**

DDMA has launched the programme in association with Silchar Municipal Board, Silchar on 03-03-2016 at Gol Dighi Municipal Mall, Silchar. The programme was attended by Sri Niharendra Narayan Thakur, Chairman, Silchar Municipal Board along with all Municipal Commissioners and representatives of the various Departments and Media houses.



8. **Students Internship Programme:** Students of Assam University, Department of Social Work has undergone their Internship programme on & from February 2016 to June 2016. Total 15 (Fifteen) nos. of students from the University has completed their Internship programme under DDMA. They have been assigned to the following works from DDMA – Preparation of Ward DM Plan, Preparation of Village Master Plan, community awareness programme and family preparedness plan for apartment dwellers in Silchar City.



9. **Training & Discussion session at IOCL Ramnagar Depot on 9th June 2016:**

DDMA has organized a training & discussion session at IOCL Ramnagar Depot on 9th June 2016 at Club House of the ICOL Ramnagar Depot. Sr. Depot Manager, IOCL Ramnagar Depot and all officers and staff including security personals of the Depot has also attended the session. This Depot is very near to Silchar City and very vulnerable for the city. So, DDMA has taken this initiative for creating awareness among the staff and nearby localities. DDMA is preparing a plan for conducting off-site mock drill in the Depot involving all response agencies and departments.



10. **School safety awareness programme & mock demonstration:**

DDMA in association with NDRF Team (Camp at Silchar) and SDRF Team has organised an awareness programme on School safety and mock demonstration in the City's School. Till 30th June 2016, we have completed in the 9 school's safety programmes in the City along with mock demonstration. From July onwards we will start Govt. office sensitization programme involving NDRF & SDRF team in the City on disaster preparedness.





11. Initiative for Drive Safe Silchar:

DDMA, Cachar in its meeting held on 19th February 2016 under the Chairmanship of the Deputy Commissioner cum Chairman, DDMA, at D. C's Conference Hall has unanimously approved the proposal for Drive Safe Silchar initiative - "No Helmet No Petrol". Accordingly, an order has been issued as per 144 Cr.P.C on 24th February 2016 and instructed the petrol pump authorities of the district not to provide fuel without helmet. Mass awareness campaign has been started involving Police authority & other departments etc. and social media campaign has also been launched for creating awareness. SmtiPrerna Sharma, IAS (P), Asst. Commissioner, Cachar initially has lead the social media campaign in the City.



12. Involvement of Scouts & Guides as a Volunteer in Assam Assembly Election 2016:

DDMA has involved the Scouts & Guides as a Volunteer in the recent concluded Assam Assembly Election 2016 in the model and women polling stations for helping old age peoples, PWD and physically weak voters during the Poll Day. Volunteers performed well and all concerned appreciated their efforts during the poll day.



13. Teachers Training at KV Srikona, Silchar:

One day Teachers Training at KV Srikona organized by DDMA in association with KV Srikona, Silchar on 4th June 2016 at the Conference Hall of the KV Srikona, Silchar. Sri Shamim Ahmed Laskar, DPO, DDMA, Cachar and Sri Rajiv Gupta, Research Scholar, Assam University has imparted the training of newly recruited KV Teachers on Basics of Disaster Management and preparation of School DM Plan including process of conducting mock exercise in the School. Total 40 nos. of teachers attended the training programme.

After Sonapur (Meghalaya) Bus accident, DDMA, Cachar has taken an initiative for preventive measures for Tourist Buses plying from Silchar and plying through Cachar district in a meeting held with ASTC, Transport Department and all Travel agencies (Govt. & Private) of the District. An order as per relevant section of DM Act 2005 has been issued by the DDMA, Cachar on 16th June 2016. Proper monitoring of implementation of the order is being carried out regularly.

Training conducted by NDRF, SDRF & Fire & Emergency Services Station Tarapur. Colleges authority agreed to constitute a Disaster Management Cell in the College for proper management.



18. 2 Day Masons Training at DRDA on 19th & 20th September 2016:

DDMA, Cachar organised masons training in association with the Assam State Disaster Management Authority, Govt. of Assam and Tata Tiscon (a corporate organization) on 19th & 20th September 2016 at DRDA Conference Hall, Silchar. 40 nos. of masons have been participated in the training from different areas of the District.



19. Lakhipur Emergency Management Exercise (LEMEx 2016) on 22nd – 23rd September 2016 at Lakhipur Sub-Division:

The Lakhipur Emergency Management Exercise (LEMEx2016) was two (2) day preparedness exercise which was conducted by the DDMA, Cachar w.e.f. 22nd to 23rd September 2016. This exercise is designed to harness the strengths and capabilities of the emergency responders, educational institutions, hospitals, Non-Governmental Organizations etc. as they prepare to meet the urban catastrophes of the Sub-Division like Lakhipur.



The initiative is planned by the Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA) in collaboration with DDMA, Cachar. The exercise was conducted in association with a number of leading local Private and Humanitarian Institutions and faculties.



This was a rigorous two days' event with five (5) parallel tracks to be held at Lakhipur Nehru College Auditorium for the table-top exercise, followed by a major incident - simulation drill on the next day. A debriefing session called "hotwash-lesson learnt session" will be conducted on the last day evening.



20. Ward DM Meeting at Ward No. 26 on 27.9.2016

DDMA has organized a ward level awareness meeting for preparation of "Ward DM Plan" and its implementation at the ground level during the disaster situation.
