The meeting was chaired by Rajib Roy, ACS, District Development Commissioner, Cachar. At the outset, he welcomed all the members present in the meeting and then started the Agenda wise Departmental discussions which were recorded as follows:

1. ASOM ADARSHA GRAM YOJANA (AAGY): The District Development Commissioner, Cachar informed the members present that the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam would be sending a team for inspection of AAGY Schemes by the first week of February, 2022 and instructed all the concerned departments to furnish the list of schemes along with photographs to the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar. The DDC also requested the Health Department to go for 100% vaccination in these villages if not done yet and instructed the concerned Departments involved in AAGY to give top priority to these schemes, apprising the House about the wish of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam to highlight the achievements in these AAGY villages as best practices in the country.

2. SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS (SDG): The District Development Commissioner, Cachar apprised the members present about the Second Edition of North Eastern Region District Sustainable Development Goals Index and Dashboard 2022. Presenting a Powerpoint Presentation with visuals of the 84 points under 16 SDG, the District Development Commissioner, Cachar instructed all the Departmental Heads to work in accordance with the 16 Sustainable Development Goals and any works undertaken by the Departments should be correlated to meet the goals of the SDG. The DDC further requested the Departmental Heads to work in tandem whenever necessary and to appoint a Nodal Officer well versed in Sustainable Development Goals to bring efficiency in meeting these goals. The DDC, Cachar also requested the members present to send the Quarterly Reports on works done to meet SDG under their respective Departments for uploading in the Dashboard.

3. **DISTRICT TEMPLATE FOR SCHEMATIC INFORMATION**: The District Development Commissioner, Cachar reminded all the members present that the 4th Quarter Report of District Template for Schematic Information to be forwarded to the Office of the Chief Secretary (OCS), M&E have not been received yet by the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Transformation & Development Branch, Cachar and gave strict instructions to send it at the earliest.

4. DCs CONFERENCE, DIPHU ACTION POINTS & MONITORABLE TARGETS: Visualizing the Action Points & Monitorable Targets of the decisions taken in the DCs Conference held at Diphu in August 2021 and the necessary steps to be taken by the concerned Departments with a Powerpoint Presentation, the District Development Commissioner, Cachar reminded the members present that the reports to be furnished is a continuous process and gave instructions to the Departmental Heads to follow up and submit their reports to the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Transformation & Development Branch, Cachar regularly for futher necessary action.

5. ASSAM CABINET MEETING IN CACHAR: The District Development Commissioner, Cachar informed the House that as decided in the last Cabinet Meeting held at Haflong, the next Cabinet Meeting would be held at Silchar, Cachar. In this regard, the DDC requested all the members present to expedite their ongoing works and submit a list of completed schemes to be considered for inauguration/ foundation stones laying ceremony by the hands of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam during the period of the Cabinet Meeting to be held at Cachar.

6. GUNOTSAV: Informing the House about the decision of the Government of Assam to implement "Gunotsav Round-III", a programme for bringing about quality improvement in education, the District Development Commissioner, Cachar instructed the Departmental Heads to provide the list of Class I & II officers working under their Departments to be involved as External Evaluators for Gunotsav.

7. PWD BUILDING: The Executive Engineer, PWD Building informed the District Development Commissioner, Cachar that the works of Sadvab Mandap under M.S.D.P. would be completed latest by March 2022. Regarding the construction of Mini Secretariat at Silchar, the EE informed the DDC that the work is almost completed and would be completed soon latest by February 2022. The District Development Commissioner, Cachar requested the Executive Engineer, PWD Building to expedite.

8. PWRD BORKHOLA & KATIGORAH: The District Development Commissioner, Cachar requested the Executive Engineer, PWRD Borkhola & Katigorah to expedite all pending works and submit demand proposal bills for works completed by 31st January 2022. The DDC, Cachar informed the EE that repairing was needed at some points at Netaji Road and requested the EE, PWRD Borkhola & Katigorah to do the needful.

9. FISHERY: The DFDO, Cachar apprised the District Development Commissioner, Cachar about the difficulty in identification of Wetland through Remote Sensing to be done as stated in the DCs Conference Action Points for Fishery Department. The DDC, Cachar advised the District Fishery Development Officer, Cachar to take the help of North Eastern Space Application Centre, Umiam, Meghalaya in this regard.

The DDC, Cachar requested to expedite after reviewing the progress report submitted by the DAO, Cachar.
